PREH RECOGNIZED BY GENERAL MOTORS AS A 2016 SUPPLIER OF THE YEAR WINNER

Novi/MI, April 10, 2017 - Preh was named a GM Supplier of the Year by General Motors during its 25th annual Supplier of the Year award ceremony held Friday, March 31 in Orlando, Florida.

GM recognized 118 of its best suppliers from 15 countries that have consistently exceeded GM's expectations, created outstanding value or brought new innovations to the company. The announcement represented the most suppliers GM has recognized since debuting the Supplier of the Year event in 1992. This is the 5th time Preh has received the award.
