PREH GROUP RECOGNIZED BY GENERAL MOTORS AS A 2018 SUPPLIER OF THE YEAR WINNER

Bad Neustadt a.d. Saale – Preh Group was named a GM Supplier of the Year by General Motors during its 27th annual Supplier of the Year awards ceremony held Wednesday, May 15 in Detroit.

During the event, GM recognized 133 of its best suppliers from 15 countries that have consistently exceeded GM's expectations, created outstanding value or introduced innovations to the company. This is the seventh time Preh GmbH has received the award.
